4	WHEREAS, Tax-related identity theft was the second most
5	common form of identity theft reported to the Federal Trade
6	Commission in 2017; and
7	WHEREAS, According to the Internal Revenue Service, more than
8	300,000 American taxpayers had their tax return details stolen
9	as a result of the 2015 security breach; and
10	WHEREAS, According to the Internal Revenue Service,
11	approximately \$1.6 billion in fraudulent tax refunds were paid
12	in 2016 related to identity theft; and
13	WHEREAS, According to the Federal Trade Commission, tax
14	refund fraud is one of the largest and fastest growing identity
15	theft categories; and
16	WHEREAS, Approximately 5,000 victims have paid more than

\$26.5 million to scammers who pose as IRS agents according to
 the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration; therefore
