## A RESOLUTION

Recognizing the week of March 15 through 21, 2020, as "National Surveyors Week" in Pennsylvania.

United States and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania today; and WHEREAS, The surveying profession requires special education, training, knowledge of mathematics and physical and applied sciences and legal requirements for evidence; and
