A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the week of March 15 through 21, 2020, as "National Surveyors Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The role of the surveyor has been, and remains, of
- 4 vital importance in the development of the United States and to
- 5 our private property rights; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Surveying requires both fieldwork and indoor work in
- 7 order to measure, maintain, monitor, verify, validate and
- 8 regulate boundaries of land, economic assets and other
- 9 properties; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Since the colonial era, surveyors have been
- 11 statesmen, leaders in the community and influential citizens;
- 12 and
- 13 WHEREAS, Former surveyors include George Washington, Thomas
- 14 Jefferson, John Adams and Abraham Lincoln; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Surveyors remain essential to the development of the

- 2 WHEREAS, The surveying profession requires special education,
- 3 training, knowledge of mathematics and physical and applied
- 4 sciences and legal requirements for evidence; and
- 5 WHEREAS, "National Surveyors Week" is an opportunity to
- 6 recognize the historic contributions of surveying and appreciate
- 7 the new technologies that are constantly modernizing the
- 8 profession; and
- 9 WHEREAS, "National Surveyors Week" has been celebrated
- 10 annually since 1984 during the week in March following the third
- 11 Sunday; therefore be it
