3	WHEREAS, Public education is the foundation of a 21st century

5	WHEREAS, The nation's public schools are where students come
6	to be educated as citizens of the United States; and
7	WHEREAS, Public schools prepare the nation's young people to
8	contribute to the economy, society and citizenry of the country;

	WHEREAS, Federal, state and local lawmakers should prioritize

other local education stakeholders and learning communities; and WHEREAS, Federal, state and local lawmakers should support such necessities as counseling, extracurricular activities and mental health supports that are critical to help students engage in learning; and

9 WHEREAS, Public schools should provide an environment where 10 all students can succeed beginning in their earliest years, 11 regardless of who they are or where they live; and 12 WHEREAS, Efforts should be supported to advance equity and 13 excellence in public education and to implement continuous 14 improvement and evidence-based practices; and

15 WHEREAS, All children have the right to an education that 16 helps them to reach their full potential and attend schools that 17 offer a high-quality educational experience; and

18 WHEREAS, Stable, equitable, predictable and adequate funding 19 for great public schools for every student in America is 20 necessary to ensure that students have inviting classrooms and 21 school libraries with up-to-date resources as well as well-22 prepared and supported educators; and

23 WHEREAS, Educators include teachers, paraprofessionals and 24 principals who provide a well-rounded and complete curriculum 25 and create joy in learning; and

26 WHEREAS, The nation's school buildings should have class 27 sizes small enough to allow students to receive one-on-one 28 attention and access support services such as health care, 29 nutrition and after-school programs when needed; and 30 WHEREAS, Students, teachers and professionals make the
