A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the week of March 8 through 15, 2020, as "AmeriCorps Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Since its creation in 1994, the AmeriCorps national
- 4 service program has proven to be highly effective in engaging
- 5 Americans of all ages and backgrounds in meeting a wide range of
- 6 community needs and promoting the ethics of service and
- 7 volunteerism; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Each year, AmeriCorps, including AmeriCorps VISTA
- 9 and AmeriCorps NCCC, provides opportunities for 75,000 citizens
- 10 across the nation, including 2,500 in this Commonwealth, to give
- 11 back in an intensive way to communities; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The Corporation for National and Community Service
- 13 has strengthened this Commonwealth's private sector by investing
- 14 more than \$34.2 million in the past year to support the efforts
- 15 of more than 100 nonprofit, community, educational and faith-
- 16 based community groups, providing grants which leveraged more
- 17 than \$33.1 million in outside resources from businesses,
- 18 foundations, public agencies and other sources, strengthening

- 1 community impact and increasing the return on taxpayer dollars;
- 2 and
- 3 WHEREAS, AmeriCorps members recruit, train and supervise
- 4 millions of volunteers annually, demonstrating AmeriCorps' value
- 5 as a powerful catalyst and volunteer force multiplier; and
- 6 WHEREAS, AmeriCorps members have served a total of more than
- 7 1.5 billion hours nationwide, including 70 million hours of
- 8 service by residents of this Commonwealth, helping to improve
- 9 the lives of this Commonwealth's most vulnerable residents,
- 10 strengthening the educational system, protecting the environment
- 11 and contributing to public safety; and
- 12 WHEREAS, AmeriCorps members nationwide, in return for their
- 13 service, have earned more than \$3.7 billion in Segal AmeriCorps
- 14 Education Awards to use to further their own educational
- 15 advancement at colleges and universities, including \$167.2
- 16 million that have been awarded to residents of this
- 17 Commonwealth; and
- 18 WHEREAS, After their terms of service end, AmeriCorps members
- 19 remain engaged in our communities as volunteers, teachers,
- 20 public servants and nonprofit leaders in disproportionately high
- 21 levels; and
- 22 WHEREAS, "AmeriCorps Week" is an opportune time for the
- 23 residents of this Commonwealth to salute AmeriCorps members of
- 24 the past and present for their powerful impact and thank all
- 25 AmeriCorps community partners in this Commonwealth who make the
- 26 program possible and bring more Americans into service;
- 27 therefore be it
- 28 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 29 week of March 8 through 15, 2020, as "AmeriCorps Week" in
- 30 Pennsylvania; and be it further
