## A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing March 22, 2020, as "World Water Day" in Pennsylvania in conjunction with the 2020 "World Water Day" international
- observance designated by the General Assembly of the United
- 4 Nations.
- 5 WHEREAS, Access to water is a fundamental human need; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Safe drinking water, sanitation and hygiene prevent
- 7 disease and save children's lives; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Water scarcity and water shortages impact billions
- 9 of lives worldwide; and
- 10 WHEREAS, In developing countries, where water collection can
- 11 consume 25% of the day, 1.3 billion people are gaining access to
- 12 safe drinking water through initiatives of the United Nations
- 13 and other global entities; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Public and private entities across all continents
- 15 must pursue unified water conservation work and continued
- 16 investment in water infrastructure to make further progress; and
- 17 WHEREAS, The first "World Water Day" observance stemmed from

- 1 the 1992 United Nations Conference on Environment and
- 2 Development; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The 2020 "World Water Day" observance is focusing on
- 4 the inextricable link between water and climate change; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The theme for 2020 "World Water Day" is "Everyone
- 6 has a role to play"; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The central message for this year's celebration is
- 8 that the way that we use water impacts climate change and asks
- 9 how can we adapt to the water effects of climate change; and
- 10 WHEREAS, It is important to use water more efficiently in
- 11 order to reduce greenhouse gases from treatment facilities; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Countries around the world are holding panel
- 13 discussions, forums, family events, cleanup events, rafting and
- 14 kayaking trips, expositions, festivals and contests to celebrate
- 15 "World Water Day" and explore innovative solutions to protect
- 16 and save lives; and
- 17 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives affirms that clean
- 18 water resources are essential to maintaining human health and
- 19 environmental integrity, alleviating poverty and hunger and
- 20 instituting global sustainable development; and
- 21 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives notes that water
- 22 quantity, water quality and equal access to water resources
- 23 positively impacts homes and workplaces and drives socioeconomic
- 24 transformation; therefore be it
- 25 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize March
- 26 22, 2020, as "World Water Day" in Pennsylvania in conjunction
- 27 with the 2020 "World Water Day" international observance
- 28 designated by the General Assembly of the United Nations.
