A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the week of May 16 through 22, 2020, as "National Safe Boating Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Every year, Pennsylvanians take to the water on
- 4 various watercraft, from yachts on Lake Erie to one-person
- 5 kayaks on the many creeks and rivers in our Commonwealth; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Safe boating practices are everyone's
- 7 responsibility; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The laws of this Commonwealth require anyone born
- 9 after January 1, 1982, to obtain a boating safety certificate to
- 10 operate a personal watercraft or powerboat with a motor greater
- 11 than 25 horsepower; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Boating safety in Pennsylvania not only includes
- 13 safe operation of the vessel but also the use of life jackets;
- 14 and
- 15 WHEREAS, There were 306,781 recreational vehicles registered
- 16 within the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission in 2018; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania had 63 reportable recreational boating
- 2 accidents of all types in 2018; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Fourteen of those 63 accidents resulted in
- 4 fatalities, which is more than 20% of all boating accidents in
- 5 this Commonwealth; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Of the 14 deaths in 2018 due to boating accidents,
- 7 11 were the result of drowning; and
- 8 WHEREAS, During the week of May 16 through 22, boating groups
- 9 throughout Pennsylvania and the country are promoting boating
- 10 safety and wearing life jackets; therefore be it
- 11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 12 week of May 16 through 22, 2020, as "National Safe Boating Week"
- 13 in Pennsylvania.
