A RESOLUTION

Designating the month of May 2016 as "Clean Water Counts Month" 1 in Pennsylvania. 2 3 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania is estimated to have more than 83,000 miles of streams, nearly 4,000 lakes and 80 trillion gallons of 4 5 groundwater; and 6 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth has approximately 19,000 miles of 7 rivers and streams that do not meet basic water quality 8 standards as a result of water pollution from a variety of 9 sources; and 10 WHEREAS, Residents of this Commonwealth rely upon clean water 11 for drinking, a wealth of recreational activities, tourism and, 12 for many, their livelihood; and 13 WHEREAS, Preventing pollution of the waters of this 14 Commonwealth and reclaiming and restoring our waterways is 15 essential to these purposes; and

1 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania's ability to attract growing businesses 2 and to provide a healthy environment for residents requires the 3 prioritization of clean water infrastructure and funding to 4 ensure the protection of clean water sources for residents of 5 this Commonwealth; and

6 WHEREAS, Clean water provides greater health, stronger 7 communities and thriving economies in all regions of our 8 Commonwealth; and

9 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives recognizes the 10 importance of clean water to the people of Pennsylvania; 11 therefore be it

12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the 13 month of May 2016 as "Clean Water Counts Month" in Pennsylvania.
