A RESOLUTION

1 Designating October 24, 2020, as "Acupuncture and Oriental
2 Medicine Day" in Pennsylvania to honor the more than 700
3 licensed acupuncturists in this Commonwealth.

5 history as components of a comprehensive traditional medical
