A RESOLUTION

- Designating May 14, 2020, as "Israel Independence Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The land of Israel is the birthplace of the Jewish
- 4 people and, despite Jewish exile, the land remains the place
- 5 where their religious, spiritual and national identity was
- 6 formed; and
- 7 WHEREAS, In 1897, the First Zionist Congress proclaimed the
- 8 right of the Jewish people to national revival in their own
- 9 country, a right acknowledged in 1917 by the Balfour Declaration
- 10 and later reaffirmed in the Mandate of the League of Nations;
- 11 and
- 12 WHEREAS, The atrocities of the Nazi Holocaust and the deaths
- 13 of millions of Jews in Europe reestablished and refocused the
- 14 need for an independent Jewish state; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The members of the National Council representing the
- 16 Jewish people in Palestine and the Zionist movement of the world
- 17 met and issued a Declaration of Israel's Independence on May 14,

- 1 1948; and
- 2 WHEREAS, On the same day, the President of the United States,
- 3 Harry S. Truman, recognized the provisional Jewish government as
- 4 de facto authority of the Jewish state; and
- 5 WHEREAS, This date is celebrated as Independence Day, a
- 6 national holiday in Israel with celebrations and observations to
- 7 commemorate this momentous occasion in establishing the State of
- 8 Israel; and
- 9 WHEREAS, In a relatively brief time and despite difficult
- 10 challenges relating to the issues of peace and security, Israel
- 11 has emerged from a fledgling state to one with a successful
- 12 democracy, a strong economy and a powerful military; therefore
- 13 be it
- 14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate May 14,
- 15 2020, as "Israel Independence Day" in Pennsylvania; and be it
- 16 further
- 17 RESOLVED, That all residents of this Commonwealth recognize
- 18 the struggles of the Israeli people for freedom in their
- 19 homeland.
