A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the month of October 2020 as "Pennsylvania
2 Pharmacists and Pharmacy Month" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, As of March 2020, this Commonwealth has 24,318
4 licensed pharmacists working toward improving medication use by
5 reducing abuse and advancing patient care in all practice
6 settings; and

7 WHEREAS, Since its founding in 1878, the Pennsylvania
8 Pharmacists Association has been a leading voice of pharmacy by
9 promoting the profession through advocacy, education and
10 communication in an effort to enhance patient care and public
11 health; and

12 WHEREAS, Pharmacists and pharmacies are responsible for
13 substantial contributions to health care in all practice
14 settings in this Commonwealth and across the nation; and

15 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Pharmacists Association is a
16 vibrant part of the pharmacy community in this Commonwealth and

1 has a diverse membership comprised of pharmacists, students,
2 technicians, part-time employees and retirees from a variety of
3 practice settings all working together to deliver the best
4 possible care for patients across this Commonwealth; and

5 WHEREAS, "Pennsylvania Pharmacists and Pharmacy Month" is a
6 time to thank our pharmacists for the work that they do and
7 promote medicinal education to the public, especially in a time
8 when health care and prescription drug abuse are major issues
9 facing this Commonwealth and the nation; therefore be it

10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
11 month of October 2020 as "Pennsylvania Pharmacists and Pharmacy
12 Month" in Pennsylvania; and be it further
