A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

- 1 Terminating the disaster emergency declared in response to the 2 protests in this Commonwealth.
- WHEREAS, 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301(c) authorizes the Governor to
- 4 declare a state of disaster emergency; and
- 5 WHEREAS, On May 30, 2020, the Governor issued a proclamation
- 6 declaring a disaster emergency in response to civil disturbances
- 7 resulting from protests in response to the death of George Floyd
- 8 on May 25, 2020; and
- 9 WHEREAS, 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301(c) authorizes the General Assembly
- 10 by concurrent resolution to terminate a state of disaster
- 11 emergency at any time; therefore be it
- 12 RESOLVED (the Senate concurring), That the General Assembly
- 13 terminate the disaster emergency declared in response to the
- 14 civil disturbances resulting from protests in response to the
- 15 death of George Floyd and direct the Governor to issue an
- 16 executive order or proclamation terminating the disaster
- 17 emergency as required under 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301(c).
