- 11 America Day" began in 1998 as the largest celebration of reading
- 12 ever held up to that point in our nation's history; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The National Education Association's "Read Across
- 14 America Day" continues to be the nation's largest reading event,

- 1 with millions of readers participating in a variety of reading
- 2 activities; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The works of Dr. Seuss, the pen name of Theodor
- 4 Seuss Geisel, continue to inspire many people of all ages to
- 5 love reading; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The National Education Association's "Read Across
- 7 America" program is held annually on Dr. Seuss' birthday to
- 8 promote reading and adult involvement in the education of our
- 9 children; therefore be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives, in support of

- 12 program, designate March 2, 2013, as "Read Across America Day"
