something meaningful away from our time spent with veterans; and WHEREAS, Whether it be inviting a veteran to speak at one of our schools or volunteering our own time to charities and other nonprofits which exist to advocate for and unite veterans in this Commonwealth, there is a responsibility which all of us should bear equal weight; and

7 WHEREAS, We as Pennsylvanians should better provide for the 8 veterans in our communities and seek to understand their stories and the sacrifices they have made on behalf of all of us; and 9 10 WHEREAS, This resolution will serve to recognize the brave men and women who have served our country admirably and continue 11 12 to represent our interests at home and abroad today; and 13 WHEREAS, This resolution aims to establish meaningful and 14 steady relationships between veterans and the people in their communities beyond Veteran's Day; therefore be it 15 16 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the 17 month of November 2020 as "Veteran Awareness Month" in 18 Pennsylvania.
