- 1 Commemorating the 75th anniversary of the Slinky.
- WHEREAS, The iconic American toy, the Slinky, is celebrating
- 3 its 75th anniversary in 2020; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The Slinky is a Pennsylvania treasure that was
- 5 introduced to the public in Philadelphia in 1945 by its creator,
- 6 Richard James, and his wife, Betty; and
- 7 WHEREAS, In 1948, James Industries built a factory to
- 8 manufacture the popular toy in suburban Philadelphia and 10
- 9 years later set up headquarters in Hollidaysburg where the
- 10 factory produces the Slinky to this day; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The Slinky has had a storied career as one of the
- 12 country's favorite toys, including a telecasted demonstration
- 13 from the Discovery Space Shuttle in 1985, a Slinky postage stamp
- 14 in 1999 and induction into the National Toy Hall of Fame in
- 15 2000; and
- 16 WHEREAS, The Slinky was acquired by Just Play, a private toy

- 1 company based in Newtown; and
- 2 WHEREAS, The company and its co-presidents, Geoffrey
- 3 Greenberg and Charlie Emby, have announced their intention to
- 4 continue creating this beloved toy for many years to come;
- 5 therefore be it
- 6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives commemorate the
- 7 75th anniversary of the Slinky, one of America's favorite toys;
