A RESOLUTION

1 2	Designating the month of September 2020 as "Choose Love and Compassion Month" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, We live in turbulent times in Pennsylvania and
4	across the nation; and
5	WHEREAS, Gun violence continues to plague our streets; and
6	WHEREAS, The COVID-19 pandemic has resulted in the loss of
7	roughly 170,000 of our family members, friends and neighbors
8	nationwide and has sickened millions more - with no end in
9	sight; and
10	WHEREAS, The tragic deaths of George Floyd, Breonna Taylor
11	and countless other persons of color have caused this country
12	and the entire world to hold a mirror up to ourselves, determine
13	who we are as a society and what we want for our children and
14	demand racial justice once and for all; and
15	WHEREAS, Tensions in our communities are at a breaking point;
16	and

WHEREAS, This is a critical moment for our nation and our
Commonwealth; and

3 WHEREAS, Now is the moment to teach our young men and women the importance of love and compassion in daily life; and 4 5 WHEREAS, In Pennsylvania, schools may establish and implement 6 a character education program to cover such topics as 7 trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness and caring -8 traits that are needed for success in life; and WHEREAS, The Office of Safe Schools and the Pennsylvania 9 10 Commission on Crime and Delinquency have grant programs 11 available to school entities to address safety and security, 12 including the establishment of conflict resolution programs; and 13 WHEREAS, Elected officials should be encouraging schools to institute programs on the importance of character and evidence-14 15 based conflict resolution plans to teach the common values of 16 love, honesty, empathy and understanding in our communities; and 17 WHEREAS, By stressing these important values, we can help stem the tide of violence in our schools and on our streets; and 18 19 WHEREAS, There are many different model programs that teach 20 character development and conflict resolution in our schools, workplaces and communities; and 21

22 WHEREAS, The Jesse Lewis Choose Love Movement teaches 23 educators and their students how to choose love in any 24 circumstance and is built upon a simple formula: courage, plus 25 gratitude, plus forgiveness, plus compassion in action equals 26 "Choosing Love"; and

27 WHEREAS, Scarlett Lewis started this movement after her young 28 son was brutally murdered at Sandy Hook Elementary School in 29 Newtown, Connecticut in 2012; and

30 WHEREAS, "Choose Love" is a community-led movement offering

1 free social and emotional learning to help people thoughtfully 2 respond to any situation or circumstance and teach children how 3 to manage their emotions, feel connected and have healthy 4 relationships; and

5 WHEREAS, Originally geared toward schools, "Choose Love" has 6 created extension programs to teach and help reinforce character 7 values outside of school, including on athletic teams, at home 8 and throughout communities; and

9 WHEREAS, "Teaching Tolerance" provides free resources to 10 educators that emphasize social justice and antibias in schools; 11 and

12 WHEREAS, "Character Counts!" is a comprehensive student 13 development program embracing academic, social and emotional 14 skills and traits, including the development of core ethical 15 traits - trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, 16 caring and citizenship; and

WHEREAS, Now more than ever, these programs should be replicated in schools, workplaces and communities throughout this Commonwealth; and

20 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives should be exploring all 21 options to help stem the tide of violence in schools and 22 communities throughout this Commonwealth, while at the same time 23 preparing our young men and women for success later in life; 24 therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the month of September 2020 as "Choose Love and Compassion Month" in Pennsylvania to encourage the inclusion of character development, ethics and conflict resolution programs in our schools, workplaces and communities.
