## AN ACT

Amending the act of July 14, 1961 (P.L.604, No.304), entitled "An act relating to apprenticeship and training; creating a 2 State Apprenticeship and Training Council in the Department 3 of Labor and Industry to formulate an apprenticeship and training policy and program, and defining its powers and 5 duties and providing for administration, "further providing 6 for powers and duties; providing for supervision; and 7 abrogating a regulation. 8 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 4 of the act of July 14, 1961 (P.L.604, 11 12 No.304), known as The Apprenticeship and Training Act, is 13 amended to read: Section 4. Powers and Duties .-- (a) The council shall (1) 14 15 establish standards for apprenticeship in conformity with the provisions of this act and applicable statutes and regulations 16 17 of the Federal Government; (2) adopt such rules and regulations, 18 subject [only] to <u>section 4.1 and</u> the approval of the Secretary 19 of Labor and Industry, as may be necessary to carry out the intent and purpose of this act; (3) compile such data on 20 population and employment trends, industrial production,

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- 1 vocational and industrial education and job requirements as may
- 2 be deemed necessary to carry out the intent and purpose of this
- 3 act; (4) to terminate or cancel any apprenticeship agreements in
- 4 accordance with the provisions of such agreements or order
- 5 modifications of such agreements; (5) maintain close liaison
- 6 with Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training, the United States
- 7 Department of Labor, the State Board of Vocational Education,
- 8 the Department of Public Instruction, the Department of
- 9 Commerce, Bureau of Rehabilitation of the Department of Labor
- 10 and Industry, and Juvenile Forestry Camps under the Department
- 11 of Public Welfare, and such other agencies which carry on
- 12 programs closely related to the purposes of this act; (6)
- 13 conduct studies, surveys and investigations of the special
- 14 problems of retraining or training unemployed or employed
- 15 persons to improve or modernize work skills and make appropriate
- 16 recommendations to cooperating agencies described above, local
- 17 community organizations, local school boards and the Secretary
- 18 of Labor and Industry; (7) act as a convening agency in local
- 19 communities to bring together local representatives of employes,
- 20 employers, educational agencies and industrial development
- 21 agencies in order to promote closer local cooperation in
- 22 establishing better apprenticeship and other training programs
- 23 including programs for employed persons who wish to improve and
- 24 modernize their work skills; (8) use appropriate media of
- 25 information and education to acquaint employers, employes and
- 26 the public at large with the advantages and availability of
- 27 apprenticeship and other occupational training programs; (9)
- 28 study the effectiveness of apprenticeship agreements and make
- 29 recommendations in accordance with the provisions of such
- 30 agreements for their improvement; and (10) perform such other

- 1 duties as may be necessary to give full effect to the provisions
- 2 of this act.
- 3 (b) The council shall make a report to the Secretary of the
- 4 Department of Labor and Industry, on or before February
- 5 fifteenth, each year, indicating the extent of apprenticeship
- 6 and other occupational training programs during the previous
- 7 year, trends in employment requiring adjustments in
- 8 apprenticeship training and other occupational programs, needs
- 9 for expansion of apprenticeship and other occupational training
- 10 programs, activities of the council and such recommendations as
- 11 are in accord with the purposes of this act.
- 12 (c) No action affecting the status of an agreement shall be
- 13 taken by the council until an attempt has been made to bring the
- 14 employes and employer together to settle the problem in
- 15 conformity with the standards of the council.
- 16 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 17 <u>Section 4.1. Supervision. -- Regulations under section 4(a)(2)</u>
- 18 may not require more than one supervisor for each apprentice or
- 19 trainee.
- 20 Section 3. The provisions of 34 Pa. Code § 83.5(b)(7) are
- 21 abrogated.
- 22 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
