AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 28, 1935 (P.L.477, No.193), entitled "An act providing for the payment of the salary, medical and 2 hospital expenses of certain employes of State and local 3 government who are injured or contract certain diseases in the performance of their duty; and providing that absence 5 during such injury shall not reduce any usual sick leave 6 period," further providing for disability benefits. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 9 hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 1 of the act of June 28, 1935 (P.L.477, 11 No.193), referred to as the Enforcement Officer Disability 12 Benefits Law (Heart and Lung Act), is amended to read: Section 1. * * * 13 14 (a.1) A person covered under subsection (a) who contracts or
- 15 is diagnosed with coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19), as
- 16 identified in the proclamation of disaster emergency issued by
- 17 the Office of the Governor on March 6, 2020, or is subject to
- quarantine resulting from exposure to COVID-19, and by reason 18
- thereof is temporarily incapacitated from performing his duties, 19

- 1 shall be compensated in accordance with subsection (a).

- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
