- 3 paragraph (2), every three years after the effective date of
- 4 this paragraph, the commission shall undertake a review of
- 5 <u>all regulations applicable to telecommunications carriers and</u>
- 6 <u>shall rescind regulations that are no longer necessary or in</u>
- 7 <u>the public interest. The commission shall not promulgate any</u>
- 8 <u>new regulation applicable to the telecommunications carriers</u>
- 9 <u>if the number of voice subscriptions subject to the</u>
- 10 commission's jurisdiction is less than 10% of the total voice
- 11 <u>subscriptions in this Commonwealth, including, but not</u>
- 12 <u>limited to, mobile wireless and Voice over Internet Protocol</u>
- 13 <u>subscriptions. If the commission promulgates any new</u>
- regulation applicable to telecommunications carriers, then
- the new regulation must be supported by factual findings and
- determinations, based on an evidentiary record, demonstrating
- 17 need for the regulation given the competitive market for
- 18 telecommunications services and that the benefits of the
- regulation outweigh the cost to comply with and enforce the
- 20 regulation.
