## AN ACT

- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in licensing of drivers, providing for declaration of judicial emergencies.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 1533.1. Declaration of judicial emergencies.
- 9 (a) Judicial emergencies. -- Notwithstanding any other
- 10 provision of this chapter, upon the IN THE EVENT OF A
- 11 <u>declaration of a judicial emergency under Article V of the</u>
- 12 Constitution of Pennsylvania, a law of this Commonwealth, a rule
- 13 of court or other judicial order by the Supreme Court or any
- 14 agency or unit of the unified judicial system exercising a power
- 15 or performing a duty under 42 Pa.C.S. § 1721 (relating to
- 16 <u>delegation of powers</u>), the department shall not suspend the
- 17 operating privilege of a person under section 1533 (relating to
- 18 suspension of operating privilege for failure to respond to

- 1 <u>citation</u>) or withhold the renewal of the driver's license of a
- 2 person under section 1503(a) (relating to persons ineligible for
- 3 <u>licensing; license issuance to minors; junior driver's license),</u>
- 4 if the time period for taking the action or making the payment
- 5 required under section 1533(a) or (b) expires during the <--
- 6 <u>declared judicial emergency PRIOR TO THE EXPIRATION OF THE</u> <--
- 7 EARLIEST TO OCCUR OF THE ADDITIONAL 30-DAY PERIODS SPECIFIED
- 8 UNDER SUBSECTION (B) (1) (I), (II) OR (III).
- 9 <u>(b) Additional compliance period.--Upon the expiration of a <--</u>
- 10 declared judicial emergency under subsection (a), a person shall
- 11 have an additional 30 days to take the action or make the
- 12 payment required under section 1533(a) or (b). If a person takes
- 13 the action or makes the payment required under section 1533(a)
- 14 or (b) within the additional 30 day time period specified under-
- 15 this subsection, the person shall be deemed in compliance with
- 16 <u>section 1533(a) or (b).</u>
- 17 <del>(c) Applicability.--</del>
- 18 <u>(1) This section shall apply to any judicial district</u>
- 19 for which a judicial emergency is declared. If a Statewide
- 20 judicial emergency is declared, this section shall apply to
- 21 <del>all judicial districts.</del>
- 22 (2) This section shall be retroactive to March 18, 2020.
- 23 (1) A PERSON SHALL HAVE AN ADDITIONAL 30 DAYS TO TAKE
- THE ACTION OR MAKE THE PAYMENT REQUIRED UNDER SECTION 1533(A)
- 25 OR (B) AFTER ANY OF THE FOLLOWING, WHICHEVER OCCURS FIRST:
- 26 (I) THE EXPIRATION OF THE DECLARED JUDICIAL
- 27 EMERGENCY UNDER SUBSECTION (A).
- 28 (II) THE JUDICIAL DISTRICT ESTABLISHES A METHOD BY
- 29 WHICH THE ACTION OR PAYMENT MAY BE COMMENCED BY RULE OF
- 30 COURT OR OTHER JUDICIAL ORDER DURING THE DECLARED

2	(III) THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE JUDICIAL EMERGENCY
3	IF THE JUDICIAL DISTRICT HAS ESTABLISHED A METHOD BY
4	WHICH THE ACTION OR PAYMENT MAY BE COMMENCED BY RULE OF
5	COURT OR OTHER JUDICIAL ORDER PRIOR TO SUCH EFFECTIVE
6	DATE.
7	(2) IF A PERSON TAKES THE ACTION OR MAKES THE PAYMENT
8	REQUIRED UNDER SECTION 1533(A) OR (B) WITHIN THE ADDITIONAL
9	30-DAY PERIODS SPECIFIED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1)(I), (II) OR
10	(III), THE PERSON SHALL BE DEEMED IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION
11	1533(A) OR (B).
12	(C) APPLICABILITY
13	(1) THIS SECTION SHALL APPLY TO ANY JUDICIAL DISTRICT
14	FOR WHICH A JUDICIAL EMERGENCY IS DECLARED. IF A STATEWIDE
15	JUDICIAL EMERGENCY IS DECLARED, THIS SECTION SHALL APPLY TO
16	ALL JUDICIAL DISTRICTS.
17	(2) THIS SECTION SHALL BE RETROACTIVE TO MARCH 18, 2020.
18	Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
