## AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 30 (Fish) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in fishing licenses, further providing for disabled veterans and former prisoners of war.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 2707 heading and (c) of Title 30 of the
7	Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended and the section
8	is amended by adding a subsection to read:
9	§ 2707. Disabled veterans [and], former prisoners of war <u>and</u>
10	<u>first responders</u> .

12	(a.2) General rule for disabled first responders
13	(1) A disabled first responder who is a resident of this
14	Commonwealth, who has a disability incurred in the line of
15	duty that prevents the individual from engaging in
16	substantial, gainful employment and who meets the
17	qualifications of section 2701 shall be issued a free
18	resident fishing license upon application to the commission

1 or a county treasurer. An application submitted by a disabled first responder shall, in addition to any information 2 required under section 2701, contain a statement that the 3 4 applicant is a 100% disabled first responder and that the qualifying disability was incurred in the line of duty and 5 6 prevents the individual from engaging in substantial, gainful\_ employment. The issuing agent or the commission may require 7 8 the production of a disability determination from a physician 9 licensed in this Commonwealth. 10 (2) As used in this subsection, the term "first responder" means an individual who serves as a member of a 11 police department, fire department or rescue agency in this 12 13 Commonwealth. 14 \* \* \* (c) Home rule and optional plan counties. -- In a county where 15 there is no county treasurer by virtue of a home rule charter or 16 17 optional plan of government, the county official who performs 18 the functions of a county treasurer and who has been designated 19 an issuing agent by the commission shall issue free and reduced 20 fee resident fishing licenses to disabled veterans [and], reduced 21 fee resident fishing licenses to former prisoners of war and 22 free resident fishing licenses to disabled first responders 23 under this section.

24 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
