AN ACT

- 1 Prohibiting certain garnishment of emergency disaster
- 2 assistance.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the COVID-19
- 7 Disaster Emergency Assistance Protection Act.
- 8 Section 2. Definitions.
- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 10 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 11 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 12 "Assistance." Any of the following received by an individual
- 13 during the COVID-19 disaster emergency:
- 14 (1) Economic Impact Payments received under the CARES
- 15 Act.
- 16 (2) Pandemic Unemployment Assistance received under the
- 17 CARES Act.

- 1 (3) Emergency Increase in Unemployment Compensation
- 2 Benefits received under the CARES Act.
- 3 (4) Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation
- 4 received under the CARES Act.
- 5 (5) Unemployment compensation received from the
- 6 Commonwealth under the act of December 5, 1936 (2nd Sp.Sess.,
- 7 1937 P.L.2897, No.1), known as the Unemployment Compensation
- 8 Law.
- 9 "CARES Act." The Federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and
- 10 Economic Security Act (Public Law 116-136, 134 Stat. 281).
- "COVID-19 disaster emergency." The duration of the
- 12 proclamation of disaster emergency issued by the Governor on
- 13 March 6, 2020, published at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020), and
- 14 any renewal of the state of disaster emergency.
- 15 Section 3. Protection from garnishment.
- Notwithstanding any provision of law, the following shall
- 17 apply during the COVID-19 disaster emergency and for an
- 18 additional 60 days following the termination of the COVID-19
- 19 disaster emergency:
- 20 (1) Any assistance received by an individual shall be
- 21 exempt from garnishment, attachment or any legal process by a
- 22 State or local government agency to satisfy any debt,
- including medical and student loan debt.
- 24 (2) Any assistance received by an individual and
- deposited into an account at a State-chartered bank or credit
- 26 union shall be exempt from garnishment, attachment or any
- legal process by a State-chartered bank or credit union to
- acquire an amount equal to or less than the amount of the
- 29 assistance for transfer from the individual's account to
- 30 another financial institution for the purpose of satisfying

- 1 any debt.
- 2 (3) No garnishment, attachment or other legal process on
- 3 any assistance received by an individual shall be commenced
- 4 or maintained by a private creditor or collection agency.
- 5 (4) This section shall not apply to garnishment,
- 6 attachment or any other legal process to satisfy child
- 7 support debt.
- 8 Section 4. Expiration.
- 9 This act shall expire 60 days following the termination of
- 10 the COVID-19 disaster emergency.
- 11 Section 5. Effective date.
- 12 This act shall take effect immediately.
