- (b) Qualifications and use of experts.--
- 7 (1) In a criminal proceeding subject to this section, a
- 8 witness may be qualified by the court as an expert if the
- 9 witness has specialized knowledge beyond that possessed by
- 10 the average layperson based on the witness's experience with,
- or specialized training or education in, criminal justice,
- behavioral sciences or victim services issues, related to
- 13 sexual violence or domestic violence, that will assist the
