AN ACT

Amending the act of July 10, 1987 (P.L.246, No.47), entitled "An act empowering the Department of Community and Economic 2 Development to assist municipalities in avoiding financial 3 distress; declare certain municipalities as financially distressed; providing for the restructuring of debt of financially distressed municipalities; limiting the ability 6 of financially distressed municipalities to obtain government 7 funding; authorizing municipalities to participate in Federal 8 debt adjustment actions and bankruptcy actions under certain 9 circumstances; authorizing certain taxes; and providing for 10 the disincorporation of municipalities and the establishment 11 of unincorporated service districts," in municipal financial 12 distress, providing for emergency plan extension. 13 14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 15 hereby enacts as follows: 16 Section 1. The act of July 10, 1987 (P.L.246, No.47), known as the Municipalities Financial Recovery Act, is amended by 17 18 adding a section to read: 19 Section 255.2. Emergency plan extension. 20 (a) Extension. -- Notwithstanding any other provision of this 21 act or law, and except as provided under subsection (b), the scheduled expiration of a plan or deadline to terminate the 22

distressed status of a municipality under this act shall be

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- 1 extended for a period of eighteen months from the effective date
- 2 of this section.
- 3 (b) Plan amendment required. -- The department shall require
- 4 <u>each plan to be amended within 60 days of the effective date of</u>
- 5 this section to, at a minimum, incorporate the extended
- 6 <u>expiration date of the plan and address any recovery objectives</u>
- 7 <u>affected by the proclamation of disaster emergency issued by the</u>
- 8 Governor on March 6, 2020, published at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21,
- 9 2020), and any renewal of the state of disaster emergency. A
- 10 plan which is not amended under this subsection shall not be
- 11 <u>extended under subsection (a).</u>
- 12 (c) Application. -- This section shall not apply to any plan
- 13 adopted by a municipality which was not distressed under this
- 14 act on the effective date of this section.
- 15 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
