Amending the act of June 27, 2006 (1st Sp.Sess., P.L.1873, No.1), entitled "An act providing for taxation by school 2 districts, for the State funds formula, for tax relief in 3 first class cities, for school district choice and voter 4 participation, for other school district options and for a 5 task force on school cost reduction; making an appropriation; 6 7 prohibiting prior authorized taxation; providing for installment payment of taxes; restricting the power of 8 certain school districts to levy, assess and collect taxes; 9 and making related repeals," in taxation by school districts, 10 11 further providing for public referendum requirements for increasing certain taxes. 12 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 1. Section 333 of the act of June 27, 2006 (1st 16 Sp.Sess., P.L.1873, No.1), known as the Taxpayer Relief Act, is 17 amended by adding a subsection to read: 18 Section 333. Public referendum requirements for increasing 19 certain taxes. 20 21 (f.1) Referendum exception for disaster emergency .--22 Notwithstanding subsection (f), a school district may, without 2.3 seeking voter approval under subsection (c), increase the rate

- 1 of a tax levied for the support of the public schools by more
- 2 than the index during the duration of the proclamation of
- 3 <u>disaster emergency issued by the Governor on March 6, 2020,</u>
- 4 published at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020), including during
- 5 the duration of any renewal of the state of disaster emergency.

- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
