AN ACT

Amending the act of September 26, 1951 (P.L.1539, No.389), 1 entitled "An act defining clinical laboratory; regulating the 2 operation of the same; requiring such laboratories to obtain 3 permits, and to be operated under the direct supervision of qualified persons; imposing certain duties upon the 5 Department of Health; and providing penalties," further providing for definitions and for exemptions. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 2 of the act of September 26, 1951 11 (P.L.1539, No.389), known as The Clinical Laboratory Act, is 12 amended by adding definitions A DEFINITION to read: <--13 Section 2. - 5 Section 2. Section 13 of the act is amended to read:
- 6 Section 13. Exemptions. -- (a) This act shall not include nor
- 7 apply to any laboratory or laboratories maintained and operated
- 8 by the Federal government; nor to any laboratory or laboratories
- 9 maintained and operated purely for research or teaching
- 10 purposes.
- 11 (b) A pharmacy or pharmacist that orders or administers <-
- 12 <u>tests for COVID 19 authorized or approved by the United States</u>
- 13 <u>Food and Drug Administration or the Centers for Disease Control</u>
