AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), entitled 1 "An act relating to the finances of the State government; 2 providing for cancer control, prevention and research, for 3 ambulatory surgical center data collection, for the Joint Underwriting Association, for entertainment business 5 financial management firms, for private dam financial 6 assurance and for reinstatement of item vetoes; providing for 7 the settlement, assessment, collection, and lien of taxes, 8 9 bonus, and all other accounts due the Commonwealth, the collection and recovery of fees and other money or property 10 due or belonging to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, 11 including escheated property and the proceeds of its sale, 12 the custody and disbursement or other disposition of funds 13 and securities belonging to or in the possession of the 14 Commonwealth, and the settlement of claims against the 15 Commonwealth, the resettlement of accounts and appeals to the 16 courts, refunds of moneys erroneously paid to the 17 Commonwealth, auditing the accounts of the Commonwealth and 18 19 all agencies thereof, of all public officers collecting moneys payable to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, 20 and all receipts of appropriations from the Commonwealth, 21 22 authorizing the Commonwealth to issue tax anticipation notes 23 to defray current expenses, implementing the provisions of section 7(a) of Article VIII of the Constitution of 24 Pennsylvania authorizing and restricting the incurring of 25 certain debt and imposing penalties; affecting every 26 department, board, commission, and officer of the State 27 government, every political subdivision of the State, and 28 29 certain officers of such subdivisions, every person, 30 association, and corporation required to pay, assess, or collect taxes, or to make returns or reports under the laws 31 imposing taxes for State purposes, or to pay license fees or 32 other moneys to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, 33

- every State depository and every debtor or creditor of the 1
- Commonwealth," in emergency COVID-19 response, providing for COVID-19 nonprofit assistance grants. 2

- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Article I-C of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343,
- 7 No.176), known as The Fiscal Code, is amended by adding a
- 8 subarticle to read:
- 9 SUBARTICLE D.1
- 10 COVID-19 NONPROFIT ASSISTANCE GRANTS
- Section 139.1-C. Definitions. 11
- 12 The following words and phrases when used in this subarticle
- 13 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- context clearly indicates otherwise: 14
- "Current fiscal year." The fiscal year beginning July 1, 15
- 16 2019, and ending June 30, 2020.
- 17 Section 139.2-C. Construction with General Appropriation Act of
- 18 2019.
- Any appropriations under this subarticle shall be in addition 19
- 20 to any appropriation under the act of June 28, 2019 (P.L.839,
- 21 No.1A), known as the General Appropriation Act of 2019, and the
- 22 act of May 29, 2020 (P.L., No.2A), known as the COVID-19
- 23 Emergency Supplement to the General Appropriation Act of 2019.
- 24 Section 139.3-C. Appropriations from account.
- 25 From the Federal amounts appropriated from the account to the
- 26 Department of Community and Economic Development for the current
- 27 fiscal year for COVID Relief - Nonprofit Assistance Grant
- Program, \$100,000,000 is appropriated for the Nonprofit 28
- 29 Assistance Grant Program established under section 139.5-C(a).
- Section 139.4-C. Continuing appropriations. 30
- 31 The appropriations under this subarticle shall be continuing

- 1 appropriations and shall not automatically lapse as of the close
- 2 the current fiscal year.
- 3 Section 139.5-C. Nonprofit Assistance Grant Program.
- 4 (a) Program establishment. -- The authority shall establish
- 5 the COVID-19 Nonprofit Assistance Grant Program.
- 6 (b) Transfer of funds. -- From money appropriated to the
- 7 Department of Community and Economic Development for COVID
- 8 Relief Nonprofit Assistance Grant Program, \$100,000,000 shall
- 9 be transferred to the authority and shall be used to make grants
- 10 <u>under the program.</u>
- 11 (c) Purpose of program. -- The program shall receive
- 12 <u>applications and award grants to nonprofit organizations in</u>
- 13 <u>accordance with this section.</u>
- 14 (d) Application. -- The authority shall develop an application
- 15 for nonprofit organizations to apply for grants under the
- 16 program within 30 days of the effective date of this section.
- 17 The application shall require an applicant to provide proof of
- 18 the applicant's status as a nonprofit organization. The
- 19 application shall be made available and posted on the
- 20 <u>authority's publicly accessible Internet website and be in a</u>
- 21 form that can be completed electronically or via United States
- 22 mail.
- 23 (e) Deadline. -- No application for a grant under the program
- 24 may be submitted after September 30, 2020.
- 25 (f) Guidelines.--The authority shall establish program
- 26 guidelines for nonprofit organizations, submit the guidelines
- 27 to the Legislative Reference Bureau for publication in the
- 28 Pennsylvania Bulletin and post the guidelines on the authority's
- 29 <u>publicly accessible Internet website.</u>
- 30 (q) Limitations. -- The following shall apply to grants under

- 1 the program:
- 2 (1) No grant may be awarded in excess of \$50,000.
- 3 (2) Grants shall only be used for costs associated with
- 4 losses relating directly to COVID-19 that occurred between
- 5 <u>March 6, 2020, and September 30, 2020.</u>
- 6 (3) No grant may be awarded to a nonprofit organization
- 7 that has received funding for losses relating directly to
- 8 <u>COVID-19 from the Commonwealth.</u>
- 9 (h) Award of grants. -- The authority shall award grants and
- 10 make grant payments under the program no later than November 30,
- 11 2020.
- 12 (i) Commonwealth Documents Law. -- This section shall not be
- 13 subject to the act of July 31, 1968 (P.L.769, No.240), referred
- 14 to as the Commonwealth Documents Law.
- 15 (j) Expiration. -- This section shall expire once all funds
- 16 <u>transferred to the authority under subsection (b) have been</u>
- 17 exhausted or December 1, 2020, whichever occurs first.
- 18 (k) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 19 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 20 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 21 "Authority." The Commonwealth Financing Authority.
- 22 "Nonprofit organization." A corporation or other entity
- 23 based in this Commonwealth which is an exempt organization as
- 24 defined under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of
- 25 1986 (Public Law 99-514, 26 U.S.C. § 501(c)(3)).
- 26 "Program." The Nonprofit Assistance Grant Program
- 27 <u>established under subsection (a).</u>
- 28 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
