## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in preliminary provisions, providing
- for interscholastic athletics during disaster emergency.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 129. Interscholastic Athletics During Disaster
- 13 Emergency. -- (a) Notwithstanding 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301 (relating to
- 14 general authority of Governor) or any other provision of law, an
- 15 <u>executive order may not prohibit a parent or guardian from</u>
- 16 monitoring, in person, the safety of their children at an
- 17 <u>interscholastic sporting event during a disaster emergency. If</u>
- 18 admission is charged for admittance into an interscholastic
- 19 sporting event, a parent or quardian under this subsection shall
- 20 be responsible for paying the admission.

- 1 (b) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 2 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 3 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 4 "Disaster emergency." A declaration of disaster emergency
- 5 made in accordance with 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301.
- 6 <u>"Interscholastic athletics."</u> All athletic contests or
- 7 competitions conducted between or among school entities.
- 8 "Interscholastic sporting event." Any of the following
- 9 <u>conducted for grades kindergarten through twelve:</u>
- 10 (1) Interscholastic athletics.
- 11 (2) An athletic contest or competition, other than
- 12 <u>interscholastic athletics</u>, that is sponsored by or associated
- 13 with a school entity, including cheerleading, club-sponsored
- 14 sports activities and sports activities sponsored by school-
- 15 affiliated organizations.
- 16 (3) Noncompetitive cheerleading that is sponsored by or
- 17 associated with a school entity.
- 18 (4) Practices, interschool practices and scrimmages for all
- 19 of the activities listed under clauses (1), (2) and (3).
- 20 "Nonpublic school." A nonprofit school, other than a school
- 21 entity, wherein a resident of this Commonwealth may legally
- 22 fulfill the compulsory school attendance requirements of this
- 23 <u>act and which meets the requirements of Title VI of the Civil</u>
- 24 Rights Act of 1964 (Public Law 88-352, 78 Stat. 241).
- 25 <u>"School entity." A school district, joint school district,</u>
- 26 charter school, regional charter school, public school,
- 27 <u>nonpublic school, private school, intermediate unit or area</u>
- 28 career and technical school.
- 29 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
