## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 1 act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in duties and powers of boards of 5 school directors, providing for publication of pathways of 6 communication. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 11 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 12 section to read: Section 510.3. Publication of Pathways of Communication .--13 14 (a) The following shall apply to a school district and each remote learning student of the school district: 15 16 (1) Within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this 17 subsection, the school district shall develop a web-based portal 18 that provides the student, parents or quardians of the student and siblings of the student access to the professional contact 19

information of the school district's administrators and

- 1 professional employes as provided under subsection (b).
- 2 (2) Within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this
- 3 subsection, the school district shall develop a web-based portal
- 4 that provides the student, parents or quardians of the student
- 5 and siblings of the student access to multiple tools needed to
- 6 promote effective remote learning. The portal must be a toolbox
- 7 of resources to provide access to:
- 8 (i) A link to resources developed by the department under
- 9 this section, including, but not limited to, modules,
- 10 instruction techniques and information that would provide
- 11 teaching techniques and tips to assist the student with online
- 12 instruction.
- 13 (ii) A link to resources developed by the school district
- 14 under this section that provides guidance and information in
- 15 support of the alignment of the student's daily online
- 16 instruction and assignments with the curriculum goal or
- 17 objective of the coursework established by the student's
- 18 <u>teacher</u>.
- 19 (iii) A link to a peer support resource page that must
- 20 contain a collection of online resources made available by the
- 21 parents, parent-teacher association, school auxiliary groups or
- 22 other similar peer support group of the school district,
- 23 organized for peer-to-peer communications to provide networking
- 24 and the exchange of ideas for effective remote access of
- 25 coursework, assistance with instruction and suggestions
- 26 regarding using online learning techniques, tips or teaching
- 27 tools and modules. The following shall apply:
- 28 (A) The peer support resource page may include links to
- 29 forums, blogs, chat lines, electronic meeting exchanges and
- 30 other types of electronic communication developed to provide

- 1 access for promoting an effective at-home school learning
- 2 environment for the student.
- 3 (B) The peer support resource page shall be developed to
- 4 permit third-party attachment of necessary access information or
- 5 <u>a link to the website</u>, if the third party has obtained
- 6 permission from the school district to participate on the peer
- 7 <u>support resource page.</u>
- 8 (C) Contents on the peer support resource page shall be
- 9 voluntarily affixed links to the various support groups.
- 10 (D) The school district shall encourage participation on the
- 11 peer support resource page.
- 12 (b) The portal to the contact information under subsection
- 13 (a)(1) shall:
- 14 (1) Be available on the publicly accessible Internet website
- 15 of the school district.
- 16 (2) Provide access to the contact information for all
- 17 administrators and professional employes in whose class or
- 18 course the student is assigned, registered or enrolled.
- 19 (c) The portal to the toolbox of resources under subsection
- 20 (a) (2) shall:
- 21 (1) Be available on the publicly accessible Internet website
- 22 of the school district.
- 23 (2) Provide access to the resources developed by the
- 24 department, the school district and peers under this section to
- 25 assist with online teaching skills and support for remote online
- 26 or distance learning.
- 27 (d) The following apply to policies:
- 28 (1) The board of school directors of a school district shall
- 29 <u>develop a written policy for the portal to the contact</u>
- 30 information under subsection (a) (1) that shall include the

- 1 following, at a minimum:
- 2 (i) The portal shall be posted on the publicly accessible
- 3 Internet website of the school district.
- 4 <u>(ii) A student assigned, registered or enrolled in a class</u>
- 5 or course in the school district, as well as the parents or
- 6 guardians of the student and the siblings of the student, shall
- 7 <u>have access to the portal.</u>
- 8 (iii) Within the portal, a student, the parents or quardians
- 9 of the student and the siblings of the student shall have a
- 10 pathway to contact information for the professional employes
- 11 associated with a class or course in which the student is
- 12 <u>assigned</u>, registered or enrolled for the school year.
- 13 <u>(iv) A remote learning student, the parents or guardians of</u>
- 14 the student and the siblings of the student shall have access to
- 15 contact information for all administrators of the school
- 16 district.
- 17 (v) An email address provided as contact information on the
- 18 portal shall be a direct link to compose and send an email
- 19 communication to an administrator or professional employe.
- 20 (vi) All outreach communications made via the contact
- 21 information provided through the portal, whether via email
- 22 application, telephone or otherwise, shall be responded to by
- 23 the individual associated with the contact information within
- 24 forty-eight (48) hours of the initial outreach effort. The
- 25 <u>response provided shall not be limited to merely an</u>
- 26 acknowledgment of receipt of the outreach communication but must
- 27 provide some responsive information to the specific details of
- 28 the outreach communication.
- 29 <u>(vii) The portal must not disclose to those who access the</u>
- 30 portal any confidential information prohibited by law from being

- 1 <u>disclosed</u>. The home address and telephone number of an
- 2 administrator or professional employe may be disclosed only if
- 3 provided by the administrator or professional employe as the
- 4 <u>contact information on the portal.</u>
- 5 (2) The board of school directors of a school district shall
- 6 develop a written policy for the portal to the toolbox of
- 7 resources under subsection (a)(2) that shall include the
- 8 following, at a minimum:
- 9 <u>(i) The portal shall be posted on the publicly accessible</u>
- 10 Internet website of the school district.
- 11 (ii) A student assigned, registered or enrolled in a class
- 12 or course in the school district, as well as the parents or
- 13 guardians of the student and the siblings of the student, shall
- 14 <u>have access to the portal.</u>
- 15 <u>(iii) The portal shall contain links and modules to provide</u>
- 16 links to teaching techniques and tips for school district-
- 17 developed quidance and information showing the alignment of the
- 18 daily lesson to the teacher's goals and objectives for the
- 19 <u>overall lesson and to a peer-to-peer resource website.</u>
- 20 (iv) Participation or inclusion of information by third
- 21 party peers is voluntary.
- 22 (v) Inclusion of information by third party peers includes
- 23 links to learning and teaching tools, blogs, chat lines,
- 24 electronic meeting exchanges and other types of electronic
- 25 communication developed to provide access for promoting an
- 26 effective at-home school learning environment and networking
- 27 efforts.
- 28 (vi) A school district, in its sole discretion, may require
- 29 permission to affix a link, module, learning technique or any
- 30 other information on the peer-to-peer resources website.

- 1 (e) A school district, in consultation with the appropriate
- 2 intermediate units and its teachers, shall:
- 3 (1) Develop curriculum goals and objectives of courses that
- 4 are offered through the school district's online or distance
- 5 <u>learning program that will align to the daily remote lesson</u>
- 6 plans assigned to the remote learning student for publication on
- 7 the portal in accordance with subsection (d) (2) (iii).
- 8 (2) Include training in remote instruction in the
- 9 professional development plan submitted by the school district
- 10 to the secretary for approval in accordance with section 1205.1.
- 11 The training included in the school district's plan for an
- 12 employe required to complete continuing professional education
- 13 shall provide up to four (4) hours every five (5) years toward
- 14 the continuing professional education requirements.
- 15 (f) The department shall:
- 16 (1) Not later than six (6) months after the effective date
- 17 of this subsection, develop guidance and material related to
- 18 instruction techniques for remote learning and tips for parents,
- 19 guardians or siblings assisting a remote learning student with
- 20 online instructions that may include materials already publicly
- 21 available.
- 22 (2) Develop a website of resources for a school district to
- 23 link in accordance with subsection (a)(2)(i). The website must
- 24 include resources that the department develops under paragraph
- 25 (1).
- 26 (3) Not later than six (6) months after the effective date
- 27 of this subsection, recommend guidelines and education materials
- 28 for the training provided under subsection (e)(2), which may
- 29 include materials already publicly available.
- 30 (g) As used in this section, the following words and phrases

- 1 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 2 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 3 "Department." The Department of Education of the
- 4 Commonwealth.
- 5 <u>"Portal." Access or a link to the contact information that a</u>
- 6 student or parent or guardian of a student can enter securely.
- 7 <u>"Remote learning student." A student attending school</u>
- 8 remotely or virtually, whether full-time or part-time.
- 9 "Secretary." The Secretary of Education.
- 10 "Sibling." A brother or sister of a student who is
- 11 registered and attending s class or course in a school district
- 12 through online or distance learning if the brother or sister is
- 13 in kindergarten through grade twelve.
- 14 "Web-based." Relating to or using the World Wide Web.
- 15 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
