AN ACT

1 Designating the bridge, identified as Bridge Key 8365, carrying  
2 Pennsylvania Route 53 over Little Conemaugh River in Croyle  
3 Township, Cambria County, as the Private Fredrick Kinley  
4 Memorial Bridge.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Private Fredrick Kinley Memorial Bridge.

8 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as  
9 follows:

10 (1) Fredrick Kinley was born January 2, 1907, in  
11 Portage.

12 (2) Mr. Kinley was drafted in February of 1944 and  
13 served during World War II in the United States Army 313th  
14 Infantry, 79th Division, Company K, which was an anti-tank  
15 company.

16 (3) Private Kinley was killed in action on December 14,  
17 1944, in France and is buried in St. Avold, France at the  
18 Lorraine American Cemetery.

19 (4) Private Kinley was awarded the Bronze Star and the

1 Purple Heart.

2 (b) Designation.--The bridge, identified as Bridge Key 8365,  
3 carrying Pennsylvania Route 53 over Little Conemaugh River in  
4 Croyle Township, Cambria County, is designated as the Private  
5 Fredrick Kinley Memorial Bridge.

6 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and  
7 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to  
8 traffic in both directions on the bridge and both directions on  
9 the crossing route.

10 Section 2. Effective date.

11 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
