## AN ACT

- Amending the act of November 10, 1999 (P.L.491, No.45), entitled "An act establishing a uniform construction code; imposing 2 powers and duties on municipalities and the Department of 3 Labor and Industry; providing for enforcement; imposing 4 penalties; and making repeals," in training and certification 5 of inspectors, providing for residential building inspectors 6 and for providers. 7 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of November 10, 1999 (P.L.491, No.45), 10

- 13 Section 704. Residential building inspectors.
- In addition to any other requirements from the department, a 14
- 15 residential building inspector shall also complete five hours of
- 16 continuing education in recognizing faulty construction
- 17 practices including proper installation of stucco, the laws and
- 18 legal liability of builders in faulty construction practices and
- 19 the remedies available under Federal or State law for homeowners
- 20 in addressing faulty construction practices.
- Section 705. Providers. 21

- 1 <u>In addition to any other providers of continuing education</u>
- 2 approved by the department, the Attorney General shall be
- 3 approved to develop and offer continuing education hours for any
- 4 <u>individuals certified under this act.</u>
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
