## AN ACT

1 2 3 4	Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous articles, providing for safe storage of a firearm when residing with a person not to possess a firearm.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
9	§ 6143. Safe storage of a firearm when residing with a person
10	<u>not to possess a firearm.</u>
11	(a) Storage requirementsA person who owns a firearm and
12	resides with a person who cannot legally possess a firearm shall
13	secure the firearm:
14	(1) with a device that, if installed on a firearm and
15	secured by means of a key or a mechanical, electronic or
16	electromechanical combination lock, prevents the firearm from
17	being discharged without first deactivating or removing the
18	device;
19	(2) with a locking mechanism incorporated into the

1	design of the firearm that prevents discharge of the firearm
2	by an individual who does not have access to the key or other
3	device designed to unlock the mechanism; or
4	(3) in a securely locked box or container or a location
5	that a reasonable person would believe to be secure.
6	(b) ExceptionSubsection (a) shall not apply if a person
7	<u>carries a firearm:</u>
8	(1) on the person's body; or
9	(2) within close enough proximity to the person's body
10	that the person is able to retrieve and use the firearm as if
11	the firearm were on the person's body.
12	(c) PenaltiesA person who violates subsection (a)
13	<u>commits:</u>
14	(1) A summary offense with no term of imprisonment when
15	the offense is a first offense.
16	(2) A misdemeanor of the third degree when the offense
17	<u>is a second or subsequent offense.</u>
18	(3) A felony of the third degree if:
19	(i) a person who cannot legally possess a firearm
20	takes possession of the firearm; and
21	(ii) the firearm is used in the commission of a
22	crime or used in an event that results in the injury or
23	<u>death of another person.</u>
24	(d) DefensesIt shall be a defense to prosecution under
25	this section if any of the following apply:
26	(1) The firearm was secured in a manner described under
27	subsection (a).
28	(2) The firearm was obtained as a result of an unlawful
29	entry by any person.
30	(3) An injury resulted from a target or sport shooting

1 <u>accident or hunting accident.</u>

2	(4) Possession of the firearm is incidental to the
3	performance of the official duties of the United States Armed
4	Forces, the Pennsylvania National Guard or the personnel of a
5	Federal, State or local law enforcement agency.
6	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
