## AN ACT

- 1 Providing for a recount of votes in certain counties, for
- separation of vote counts and for a report by the Department
- of State relating to the 2020 general election.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Short title.
- 7 This act shall be known and may be cited as the 2020 General
- 8 Election Act.
- 9 Section 2. Definitions.
- 10 Definitions.--As used in this section, the following words
- 11 and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 12 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 13 "Department." The Department of State of the Commonwealth.
- 14 "Election." The general election held on November 3, 2020.
- 15 Section 3. Recount of votes.
- 16 (a) Recount.--If a court determines that a county violated
- 17 the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the
- 18 Pennsylvania Election Code, in the conduct of the election, or a

- 1 county election official or poll worker submits a sworn
- 2 affidavit to the department or a district attorney alleging a
- 3 county violated the Pennsylvania Election Code in the conduct of
- 4 the election, the county shall recount the votes cast.
- 5 (b) Expenses. -- Any expenses of a county associated with
- 6 recount under subsection (a) shall be paid by the department.
- 7 Section 4. Separation of vote counts.
- 8 A county shall do the following:
- 9 (1) Keep a separate count of votes from ballots received
- prior to 8 p.m. on November 3, 2020.
- 11 (2) Keep a separate count of votes from ballots received
- after 8 p.m. on November 3, 2020, and delivered by 5 p.m.
- November 6, 2020, that were postmarked by 8 p.m. on November
- 14 3, 2020.
- 15 Section 5. Report to General Assembly.
- 16 (a) Report. -- The department shall submit a report to the
- 17 General Assembly regarding how the following complaints relating
- 18 to the election were investigated:
- 19 (1) Complaints submitted to the Bureau of Commissions,
- 20 Elections and Legislation of the department regarding
- 21 violations of Title III of the Help America Vote Act of 2002
- 22 (Public Law 107-252, 42 U.S.C. § 15301 et seq.).
- 23 (2) Complaints submitted to the department through the
- department's formal election complaint publicly accessible
- 25 Internet website.
- 26 (3) Complaints submitted to the department through the
- voter hotline.
- 28 (b) Contents. -- The information in the report under
- 29 subsection (a) shall include the complaint, polling precinct and
- 30 county in which the complaint originated, what actions the

- 1 department took to investigate the complaint and the outcome of
- 2 the investigation.
- 3 (c) Submission.--The department shall submit the report to
- 4 the General Assembly within 30 days of the effective date of
- 5 this section.
- 6 Section 6. Effective date.
- 7 This act shall take effect immediately.
