## AN ACT

Amending Title 30 (Fish) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in fishing licenses, further providing for disabled 2 veterans and former prisoners of war; and making an editorial 3 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 2707 heading and (c) of Title 30 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended and the section 9 is amended by adding a subsection to read: 10 § 2707. Disabled veterans [and], former prisoners of war and 11 first responders. 12 (a.2) General rule for disabled first responders.--13 (1) A disabled first responder who is a resident of this 14 15 Commonwealth, who has a disability incurred in the line of 16 duty that prevents the individual from engaging in 17 substantial, gainful employment and who meets the qualifications of section 2701 shall be issued a free 18 19 resident fishing license upon application to the commission

- or a county treasurer. An application submitted by a disabled
- 2 <u>first responder shall, in addition to any information</u>
- 3 <u>required under section 2701, contain a statement that the</u>
- 4 <u>applicant is a 100% disabled first responder and that the</u>
- 5 <u>qualifying disability was incurred in the line of duty and</u>
- 6 prevents the individual from engaging in substantial, gainful
- 7 <u>employment. The issuing agent or the commission may require</u>
- 8 <u>the production of a disability determination from a physician</u>
- 9 licensed in this Commonwealth.
- 10 (2) As used in this subsection, the term "first
- 11 <u>responder" means an individual who serves as a member of a</u>
- 12 police department, fire department or rescue agency in this
- 13 Commonwealth.

- 15 (c) Home rule and optional plan counties. -- In a county where
- 16 there is no county treasurer by virtue of a home rule charter or
- 17 optional plan of government, the county official who performs
- 18 the functions of a county treasurer and who has been designated
- 19 an issuing agent by the commission shall issue free and reduced
- 20 fee resident fishing licenses to disabled veterans [and],\_
- 21 reduced fee resident fishing licenses to former prisoners of war
- 22 and free resident fishing licenses to disabled first responders
- 23 under this section.
- Section 2. Section 2907.2(c) of Title 30 is amended to read:
- 25 § 2907.2. Lake Erie fishing permits.

- 27 (c) Exemptions.—Persons entitled to free fishing licenses
- 28 under section 2707 (relating to disabled veterans, former
- 29 <u>prisoners of war and first responders</u>) and persons exempt from
- 30 fishing license requirements under Chapter 27 (relating to

- 1 fishing licenses) are exempt from the requirements of this
- 2 section. Holders of Senior Resident Lifetime Fishing Licenses
- 3 issued under section 2701 (relating to resident fishing
- 4 licenses) shall meet the requirements of this section by
- 5 purchasing one annual special permit which shall be valid for
- 6 the licensee's lifetime.

- 8 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
