- 12 (a) General rule. -- The following persons shall be required
- 13 to provide information regarding the availability of veterans'
- 14 <u>burial benefits to a purchaser of funeral merchandise or a</u>

- 16 (1) A licensed funeral director.
- 17 (2) A funeral entity.
- 18 (3) A cemetery company.
- 19 (b) Required information. -- At a minimum, information on the
- 20 following shall be provided:
- 21 (1) Burial benefits and allowances, flags to be draped
- 22 over caskets and headstones and markers, as provided under 38
- 23 U.S.C. Ch. 23 (relating to burial benefits).
- 24 (2) Burial in national cemeteries as provided under 38
- 25 U.S.C. § 2402 (relating to persons eligible for interment in
- 26 national cemeteries).
- 27 (3) Presidential memorial certificates as provided under
- 38 U.S.C. § 112 (relating to Presidential memorial
- 29 <u>certificate program</u>).
- 30 (4) Military funeral honors as provided under 10 U.S.C.

- 2 veterans).
- 3 (c) Affidavit. -- A funeral director, funeral entity and
- 4 <u>cemetery company shall require a purchaser to sign an affidavit</u>
- 5 <u>indicating that the information was supplied prior to the</u>
- 6 purchase of any funeral merchandise or burial lot.
- 7 (d) Penalty. -- A funeral director or officer of a cemetery
- 8 company who fails to furnish the required information commits a
- 9 <u>misdemeanor of the third degree.</u>
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
