## AN ACT

- 1 Providing for the capital budget for the fiscal year 2019-2020
- and for limitation on redevelopment assistance capital
- projects; and making a related repeal.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Short title.
- 7 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Capital
- 8 Budget Act of 2019-2020.
- 9 Section 2. Overall limitations on debt to be incurred for
- 10 capital projects.
- 11 The maximum principal amount of additional debt to be
- 12 incurred during the 2019-2020 fiscal year, and thereafter until
- 13 the enactment of the 2020-2021 capital budget specifying the
- 14 maximum debt for the 2020-2021 fiscal year, for capital projects
- 15 specifically itemized in a capital budget pursuant to section
- 16 7(a)(4) of Article VIII of the Constitution of Pennsylvania, and
- 17 the fund to be charged with the repayment of such debt, shall,
- 18 with respect to each category of capital projects, be as

- 20 Section 2.1. Limitation on redevelopment assistance capital
- 21 projects.
- The following limitations shall apply to redevelopment
- 23 assistance capital projects:
- 24 (1) Subject to adjustment under paragraph (2) or (3),
- 25 the maximum amount of redevelopment assistance capital
- 26 projects undertaken by the Commonwealth for which obligations
- are outstanding shall not exceed, in aggregate,
- 28 \$3,350,000,000.
- 29 (2) Beginning July 1, 2018, and each July 1 thereafter
- 30 until the sum of the outstanding obligations for

- 1 redevelopment assistance capital projects equals
- 2 \$3,150,000,000 \$3,100,000,000 or July 1, 2021 2022, whichever <--
- 3 occurs first, the sum of the maximum amount of outstanding
- 4 obligations for redevelopment assistance projects shall be
- 5 decreased by \$50,000,000.
- 6 (3) Beginning July 1, 2022, and each July 1 thereafter <--
- 7 until the sum of the outstanding obligations for
- 8 redevelopment assistance capital projects equals—
- 9 \$2,975,000,000, the sum of the maximum amount of outstanding
- 10 <u>obligations for redevelopment assistance projects shall be</u>
- 11 decreased by \$50,000,000.
- 12 Section 2.2. Repeals are as follows:
- 13 (1) The General Assembly declares that the repeal under
- 14 paragraph (2) is necessary to effectuate the addition of
- 15 section 2.1.
- 16 (2) Section 317(b) of the act of February 9, 1999
- 17 (P.L.1, No.1), known as the Capital Facilities Debt Enabling
- 18 Act, is repealed.
- 19 Section 3. Effective date.
- 20 This act shall take effect July 1, <del>2019</del> 2020, or immediately, <--
- 21 whichever is later.
