Section 9121(b)(1) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 10 11 § 9121. General regulations. * * * 12 13 (b) Dissemination to noncriminal justice agencies and individuals .-- Criminal history record information shall be 14 15 disseminated by a State or local police department to any 16 individual or noncriminal justice agency only upon request. 17 Except as provided in subsection (b.1): 18 A fee may be charged by a State or local police 19 department for each request for criminal history record

information by an individual or noncriminal justice agency,

- 1 except that no fee shall be charged to an individual who
- 2 makes the request in order to apply to become a volunteer <u>and</u>
- 3 <u>serve without compensation</u> with an affiliate of <u>Little League</u>
- 4 <u>Baseball, Inc.</u>, Big Brothers of America or Big Sisters of
- 5 America or with a rape crisis center or domestic violence
