AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in abortion, further providing for
- definitions and for medical consultation and judgment.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 3203 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a definition to read:
- 8 § 3203. Definitions.
- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 10 shall have, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the
- 11 meanings given to them in this section:

- 13 "Down syndrome." A chromosome disorder associated with an
- 14 extra chromosome 21, in whole or in part, or an effective
- 15 <u>trisomy for chromosome 21.</u>

- 17 Section 2. Section 3204(c) of Title 18 is amended to read:
- 18 § 3204. Medical consultation and judgment.

1 2 (c) Factors. -- The following shall apply: 3 (1) In determining in accordance with subsection (a) or 4 (b) whether an abortion is necessary, a physician's best 5 clinical judgment may be exercised in the light of all 6 factors (physical, emotional, psychological, familial and the woman's age) relevant to the well-being of the woman. [No 7 abortion which is sought solely because of the sex of the 8 9 unborn child shall be deemed a necessary abortion.] 10 (2) No abortion shall be deemed necessary if sought exclusively for either or both of the following reasons: 11 12 (i) The sex of the unborn child. (ii) A prenatal diagnosis of or belief that the
