AN ACT

- Amending Title 44 (Law and Justice) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in Pennsylvania State Police, 2 providing for animal abuse registry; and imposing duties on the Pennsylvania State Police. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. - 2 § 2501. Definitions.
- 3 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 4 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 5 <u>context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 6 "Animal abuse." Any of the following:
- 7 (1) A violation of 18 Pa.C.S. § 5534 (relating to
- 8 <u>aggravated cruelty to animal).</u>
- 9 (2) A violation of another law of this Commonwealth
- 10 regarding the protection or violation of animals, if the
- 11 <u>violation constitutes a felony.</u>
- 12 (3) A violation similar to a violation under paragraph
- (1) or (2) that is committed under the laws of the United
- 14 States or one of its territories or possessions, another
- 15 <u>state, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto</u>
- Rico or a foreign country. This paragraph shall only apply if
- 17 the person committing the violation is domiciled in this
- 18 <u>Commonwealth.</u>
- 19 "Registry." The animal abuse registry established under
- 20 <u>section 2503</u> (relating to establishment of registry).
- 21 <u>"State police." The Pennsylvania State Police.</u>
- 22 § 2502. Animal abuse information.
- 23 (a) Duty of clerk of court.--The clerk of court of each
- 24 judicial district in this Commonwealth shall forward a certified
- 25 copy of the judgment of an individual who has been convicted of,
- 26 pleaded guilty to or entered a plea of nolo contendere to animal
- 27 <u>abuse</u>, along with the date of birth of the individual, to the
- 28 State police within 60 calendar days after the date of judgment.
- 29 (b) Duty of State police. -- The State police shall receive
- 30 the information under subsection (a) and information from

- 1 <u>another jurisdiction regarding an individual who has been</u>
- 2 <u>convicted of, pleaded quilty to or entered a plea of nolo</u>
- 3 <u>contendere to animal abuse.</u>
- 4 § 2503. Establishment of registry.
- 5 The State police shall establish and maintain a registry of
- 6 <u>individuals</u> who have been convicted of, pleaded guilty to or
- 7 entered a plea of nolo contendere to animal abuse.
- 8 <u>§ 2504. Contents of registry.</u>
- 9 <u>Upon receiving the information under section 2502(b)</u>
- 10 (relating to animal abuse information), the State police shall
- 11 enter the individual's information into the registry. Each entry
- 12 into the registry:
- 13 (1) Shall include the following:
- 14 (i) The individual's full legal name.
- 15 (ii) The date of the animal abuse committed by the
- individual.
- 17 (iii) A description of the animal abuse.
- 18 (iv) The photograph of the individual that was taken
- 19 at the booking center after the individual was charged
- with animal abuse.
- 21 (v) Other information regarding the individual as
- 22 the State police determines is necessary to properly
- 23 identify the individual as a perpetrator of animal abuse
- 24 and exclude innocent individuals from false
- 25 identification.
- 26 (2) Shall not include the individual's Social Security
- 27 <u>number, driver's license number or any other Federal or State</u>
- 28 identification number.
- 29 <u>§ 2505. Maintenance of information in registry.</u>
- 30 (a) First offense. -- The State police shall maintain the

- 1 <u>information under section 2504</u> (relating to contents of
- 2 registry) in the registry for two years from the date that the
- 3 individual was convicted of, pleaded quilty to or entered a plea
- 4 <u>of nolo contendere to animal abuse.</u>
- 5 (b) Subsequent offenses.--If, during any time period that
- 6 <u>information regarding an individual is contained in the</u>
- 7 registry, the individual is convicted of, pleads quilty to or
- 8 <u>enters a plea of nolo contendere to a subsequent charge of</u>
- 9 animal abuse, the State police shall maintain the information
- 10 under section 2504 for five years from the date of the
- 11 <u>individual's most recent conviction</u>, guilty plea or entry of a
- 12 plea of nolo contendere to animal abuse.
- 13 (c) Removal of information.--If, during the time period
- 14 under subsection (a) or (b), the individual is not convicted of,
- 15 does not plead guilty to and does not enter a plea of nolo
- 16 <u>contendere to a subsequent charge of animal abuse, the State</u>
- 17 police shall remove the information regarding the individual
- 18 from the registry upon the expiration of that period.
- 19 § 2506. Posting of information in registry.
- The State police shall post on its publicly accessible
- 21 Internet website the contents of the registry under section 2504
- 22 (relating to contents of registry).
- 23 § 2507. Expungement.
- 24 Upon the review of a petition of an individual who was
- 25 <u>convicted of, pleaded guilty to or entered a plea of nolo</u>
- 26 contendere to animal abuse and upon good cause shown, a court of
- 27 competent jurisdiction may order the expungement of the
- 28 individual's criminal history information regarding animal
- 29 <u>abuse. If expungement is ordered, the State police</u> shall
- 30 immediately remove all the information subject to the

- 1 <u>expungement from the registry and the publicly accessible</u>
- 2 Internet website.
- 3 § 2508. Rules and regulations.
- 4 The State police shall promulgate rules and regulations
- 5 necessary to implement the provisions of this chapter.
- 6 Section 2. The addition of 44 Pa.C.S. Ch. 25 shall apply to
- 7 individuals who have been convicted of, pleaded guilty to or
- 8 entered a plea of nolo contendere to animal abuse on or after
- 9 the effective date of this act.
- 10 Section 3. This act shall take effect January 1, 2020.
