9	Section 1. The sum of \$49,723,000 \$55,525,000, or as much <
10	thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
11	Professional Licensure Augmentation Account within the General
12	Fund to the Department of State for the operation of the Bureau
13	of Professional and Occupational Affairs, including the State
14	Board of Auctioneer Examiners, for the fiscal year July 1, 2019,
15	to June 30, 2020.
16	Section 2. (a) The sum of \$9,031,000 \$9,581,000, or as much <
17	thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
18	restricted receipts account of the State Board of Medicine for
19	the operation of the board for the fiscal year July 1, 2019, to
20	June 30, 2020.

1 (b) The sum of \$2,422,000 \$2,564,000, or as much thereof as <--2 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the restricted 3 receipts account of the State Board of Osteopathic Medicine for 4 the operation of the board for the fiscal year July 1, 2019, to 5 June 30, 2020.

(c) The sum of \$300,000 \$420,000, or as much thereof as may <--
7 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the restricted
8 receipts account of the State Board of Podiatry for the
9 operation of the board for the fiscal year July 1, 2019, to June
10 30, 2020.

(d) The sum of \$647,000 \$845,000, or as much thereof as may <--</p>
be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the Athletic
Commission Augmentation Account for the State Athletic
Commission, as authorized by 5 Pa.C.S. § 1512 (relating to
Athletic Commission Augmentation Account), for the support and
operation of the commission for the fiscal year July 1, 2019, to
June 30, 2020.

(e) Each appropriation listed in subsections (a), (b), (c)
and (d) shall not be treated as an augmentation to the
Department of State, a general government appropriation or any
other appropriation, but shall be treated and accounted for as
separate appropriations respectively.

23 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019, or 24 immediately, whichever is later.
