- 10 Section 202. Notification.
- 11 An entity shall provide notification to each resident,
- 12 municipality and other applicable party affected by the drilling
- 13 of a pipeline at least five days prior to the initiation of a

- 15 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
