AN ACT

Amending the act of November 29, 2006 (P.L.1435, No.156), 1 entitled "An act relating to confidential security 2 information of public utilities; and imposing penalties," 3 further providing for definitions; providing for pipeline operation and emergency response plans; and further providing 5 for prohibition. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 2 of the act of November 29, 2006 10 (P.L.1435, No.156), known as the Public Utility Confidential Security Information Disclosure Protection Act, is amended by 11 12 adding definitions to read: 13 Section 2. Definitions. 14 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall 15 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the 16 context clearly indicates otherwise: 17 * * * "Gas." - (3) The disclosure permitted under paragraph (2) shall be made only after the county emergency management agency director, with authority to bind the county emergency management agency, agrees to and signs a nondisclosure agreement which, in the judgment of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, contains adequate protections against the unauthorized or inadvertent disclosure of confidential security information.
