AN ACT

- 1 Providing for the establishment of sexual harassment and sexual
- violence online reporting system by postsecondary
- 3 institutions.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Short title.
- 7 This act shall be known and may be cited as the College
- 8 Sexual Harassment and Sexual Violence Online Reporting System
- 9 Act.
- 10 Section 2. Definitions.
- 11 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 12 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 13 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "Online reporting system." A system established under
- 15 section 3.
- 16 "Postsecondary institution." Any of the following:
- 17 (1) A community college as defined under section 1901-A
- 18 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the

- 1 Public School Code of 1949.
- 2 (2) A university under the jurisdiction of the State
- 3 System of Higher Education.
- 4 (3) A university located in this Commonwealth that
- 5 receives a nonpreferred appropriation.
- 6 (4) A private postsecondary institution.
- 7 Section 3. Online reporting system.
- 8 (a) Establishment of online reporting system. -- A
- 9 postsecondary institution shall establish and maintain an online
- 10 reporting system to receive complaints of sexual harassment and
- 11 sexual violence from students and employees. A report shall be
- 12 investigated through the process established in the
- 13 postsecondary institution's sexual harassment and sexual
- 14 violence policy. A postsecondary institution may not fail or
- 15 refuse to investigate an anonymous report because it is
- 16 anonymous.
- 17 (b) Anonymous reports. -- The online reporting system shall
- 18 permit anonymous reports, which shall be investigated in
- 19 accordance with subsection (a).
- 20 (c) Required information. -- A postsecondary institution shall
- 21 provide students and employees making reports under this section
- 22 with the following:
- 23 (1) Information regarding who will receive and have
- 24 access to the reports filed.
- 25 (2) How information gathered through the online
- 26 reporting system will be used.
- 27 (3) Contact information for on-campus and off-campus
- organizations serving victims of sexual harassment and sexual
- 29 violence.
- 30 (d) Statement. -- The online reporting system shall

1 prominently display the following statement:

It is important to note that while the institution will evaluate all reports of sexual assault and sexual harassment, the institution's ability to investigate and respond to allegations may be limited depending on the information provided in the report. Individuals are encouraged to review the institution's policy for investigating reports of sexual violence for more information about procedures and resources.

- 10 (e) Access to data.--A postsecondary institution shall limit
 11 access to the data collected, created or maintained under
 12 subsection (a) to only the data subject and as follows:
 - (1) Only individuals with explicit authorization from a postsecondary institution may enter, update, access, share or disseminate electronic data related to an incident of sexual harassment or sexual violence collected, created or maintained under this section.
 - (2) The ability of an authorized individual to enter, update, access, share or disseminate data must be limited through the use of role-based access that corresponds to the official duties or training level of the individual and the institutional authorization that grants access for that purpose.
 - (3) Actions in which the data related to an incident of sexual harassment or sexual violence are entered, updated, accessed, shared or disseminated outside the postsecondary institution must be recorded in a data audit trail.
 - (4) An institution shall immediately and permanently revoke the authorization of an individual determined to have willfully entered, updated, accessed, shared or disseminated

- data in violation of this section.
- 2 (f) Appropriations. -- The Secretary of the Budget shall
- 3 withhold funds appropriated on behalf of a postsecondary
- 4 institution that fails to establish and maintain the online
- 5 reporting system required under this act. Funds withheld by the
- 6 secretary from a postsecondary institution shall lapse back to
- 7 the General Fund at the end of the fiscal year for which they
- 8 are appropriated.
- 9 Section 4. Effective date.
- 10 This act shall take effect in one year.
