## A JOINT RESOLUTION

| 6           | Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of   |
| 7           | Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:   |
| 8           | That section 3 of Article II be amended to read:  |
| 9           | § 3. Terms of members.  |
| 10          | Senators shall be elected for the term of four years and  |
| 11          | Representatives for the term of two years. <u>No member of the</u>  |
| 12          | <u>General Assembly may serve more than a total of twelve years in</u>  |
| 13          | the Senate and a total of twelve years in the House of  |
| 14          | Representatives over the course of the member's lifetime.   |
| 15          | Section 2. The provisions of this resolution will only  |
| 16          | affect members of the General Assembly elected from the first   |
| 17          | election cycle following the ratification of this constitutional  |
| 18          | amendment and thereafter.   |

1 Section 3. (a) Upon the first passage by the General 2 Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the 3 Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article 4 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the 5 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in 6 7 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after 8 passage of this proposed constitutional amendment.

9 (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this 10 proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the 11 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the 12 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the 13 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required 14 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such 15 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of 16 this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the 17 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment 18 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first 19 primary, general or municipal election which meets the 20 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article 21 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least three months after the proposed constitutional amendment is 22 23 passed by the General Assembly.
