## AN ACT

11	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
12	hereby enacts as follows:
13	Section 1. The act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130),
14	known as The County Code, is amended by adding a section to

16	Section 1808. Voting by county commissioner on certain
17	appointments(a) A county commissioner may not vote on the
18	appointment of a member of a board, authority or similar body
19	established to improve the economic development of the county if
20	a member of the immediate family of the county commissioner is
21	an executive level employe of the board, authority or similar
22	hody or is employed by an entity that receives a grant loan or

1	<u>contract from the board, authority or similar body.</u>
2	(b) A county commissioner under subsection (a) shall refrain
3	from voting in accordance with 65 Pa.C.S. § 1103(j) (relating to
4	restricted activities).
5	(c) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
6	shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection:
7	"Executive-level employe" shall mean an employe of a board,
8	authority or similar body established by the county
9	commissioners with discretionary powers that may affect the
10	outcome of a decision in relation to a private corporation or
11	business or an employe who by virtue of the employe's job
12	function could influence the outcome of a decision.
13	"Immediate family" shall mean a parent, spouse, child,
14	<u>brother or sister.</u>
15	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
