11	(a) Offense defined A person commits an offense if:
12	(1) The person intentionally, knowingly or recklessly
13	kills, maims, disfigures, tortures or administers poison or
14	exposes a poisonous substance with intent to administer the
15	poison or poisonous substance to a dog or cat that is owned
16	by or resides with a person protected by an order issued
17	under 23 Pa.C.S. Ch. 61 (relating to protection from abuse)
18	or 42 Pa.C.S. Ch. 62A (relating to protection of victims of

- 1 <u>sexual violence or intimidation).</u>
- 2 (2) The person committing the violation under paragraph
- 3 (1) is the subject of the order issued under 23 Pa.C.S. Ch.
- 4 61.
- 5 (b) Grading. -- A violation of this section is a felony of the
- 6 third degree.
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
