AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," in school directors, further 5 providing for board of directors and election or appointment 6 7 and for school board in first class A school districts and appointment of seats, and numbers, terms, and methods for 8 election of school directors in first class A school 9 districts. 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1. Sections 301 and 302.1(d) of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, 14 15 are amended to read: 16 Section 301. Board of Directors; Election or Appointment. --(a) The public school system of the Commonwealth shall be 17 18 administered by a board of school directors, to be elected or 19 appointed, as hereinafter provided. At each election of school 20 directors, each qualified voter shall be entitled to cast one 21 vote for each school director to be elected. Any system

- 1 director is hereby abolished.
- 2 (b) Excluding school districts where the board of school
- 3 <u>directors is appointed, except as provided in subsections (c)</u>
- 4 and (d), school directors shall be elected in accordance with
- 5 the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the
- 6 "Pennsylvania Election Code."
- 7 (c) A primary election for school director nominations shall
- 8 <u>not be held for the 2021 municipal elections and thereafter.</u>
- 9 School directors shall be elected at the November municipal
- 10 <u>election beginning in 2021.</u>
- 11 (d) Notwithstanding section 951 of the "Pennsylvania"
- 12 <u>Election Code," nomination papers for the office of school</u>
- 13 <u>director shall be filed in the same manner as nominations of</u>
- 14 candidates by political bodies or independent candidates, as
- 15 provided by the "Pennsylvania Election Code," without regard to
- 16 political party membership. Nomination papers for the office of
- 17 school director must include the signatures of a minimum number
- 18 of qualified electors, without regard to political party
- 19 affiliation as follows:
- 20 (1) Two hundred for a school district of the first class A.
- 21 (2) One hundred for a school district of the second class.
- 22 (3) Fifty for a school district of the third class.
- 23 (4) Twenty-five for a school district of the fourth class.
- 24 Section 302.1. School Board in First Class A School
- 25 Districts; Apportionment of Seats, and Numbers, Terms, and
- 26 Methods for Election of School Directors in First Class A School

- [(d) Nomination and Elections of School Directors. School
- 29 directors shall be nominated and elected in accordance with the
- 30 act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the

"Pennsylvania Election Code."] 1

- Section 2. All acts and parts of acts are repealed insofar 3
- as they are inconsistent with this act. 4
- 5 Section 3. This act shall take effect as follows:
- 6 (1) The amendment of section 301 of the act shall take effect December 31, 2020. 7
- This section shall take effect immediately. 8 (2)
- (3) The remainder of this act shall take effect in 60 9
- 10 days.
