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## AN ACT

Consolidated Statutes, in ethics standards and financial 2 disclosure, further providing for statement of financial 3 interests required to be filed and for powers and duties of 5 commission. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. Section 1104(e) of Title 65 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is amended by 10 adding a subsection to read: 11 § 1104. Statement of financial interests required to be filed. 12 \* \* \* (a.1) Statewide official and member of the General 13 Assembly. -- Beginning May 1, 2020, and each May 1 thereafter, a 14 15 Statewide official and member of the General Assembly shall file 16 electronically the statement of financial interests required under subsection (a). The filing must be in a form and manner 17 prescribed by the commission. 18

- 1 (e) Public inspection and copying. -- All statements of
- 2 financial interests filed pursuant to the provisions of this
- 3 chapter shall be:
- 4 <u>(1)</u> made available for public inspection and copying
- 5 during regular office hours, and copying facilities shall be
- 6 made available at a charge not to exceed actual cost[.]; and
- 7 (2) posted on the publicly accessible Internet websites
- 8 of the commission and other State agencies that receive and
- 9 <u>file statements of financial interests.</u>
- 10 Section 2. Section 1107(6) and (7) of Title 65 are amended
- 11 and the section is amended by adding paragraphs to read:
- 12 § 1107. Powers and duties of commission.
- In addition to other powers and duties prescribed by law, the
- 14 commission shall:
- 15 \* \* \*
- 16 (6) (i) Provide that statements and reports filed with
- 17 the commission be made available for public inspection
- and copying during regular office hours and provide that
- 19 copying facilities be made available at a charge not to
- 20 exceed actual cost [and advise].
- 21 (ii) Post on its publicly accessible Internet
- 22 website the statements of financial interests required to
- be filed with it.
- 24 (iii) Advise other State and local agencies of the
- 25 provisions of this paragraph.
- 26 (7) Compile and maintain an index, including a database
- 27 <u>on its publicly accessible Internet website</u>, of all reports
- and statements filed with the commission to facilitate public
- 29 access to such reports and statements and instruct other
- 30 State and local agencies which receive and file financial

1	interest statements in the maintenance of systems, including
2	publicly accessible Internet websites, which facilitate
3	public access to such statements. The database required under
4	this paragraph shall be searchable and sortable by, at a
5	minimum, the following:
6	(i) The name of the individual filing the report or
7	statement.
8	(ii) The office held by the individual filing the
9	report or statement.
10	(iii) The year the form was filed.
11	(iv) Whether or not the form is an amended filing.
12	The database required under this paragraph shall be
13	operational no later than May 1, 2020.
14	(7.1) Connect an amended filing to the original filing
15	on its publicly accessible Internet website in a way that a
16	person accessing one will be notified of the existence of the
17	other.
18	(7.2) Provide an e-mail notification option for a person
19	who would like to be notified of new filings.

21	Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
