## AN ACT

- Amending Title 65 (Public Officers) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in ethics standards and financial disclosure, further providing for definitions and adding a 3 definition of "State-related institution and its affiliates." 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. The definitions of "governmental body," 7 8 "governmental body with which a public official or public employee is or has been associated," "public employee" and 9 "public official" in section 1102 of Title 65 of the 10 11 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is amended by adding a definition to read: 12 § 1102. Definitions. 13 14 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter 15 shall have, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the 16 meanings given to them in this section:
- "Governmental body." Any department, authority, commission,

19 committee, council, board, bureau, division, service, office,

- 1 officer, administration, legislative body or other establishment
- 2 in the executive, legislative or judicial branch of a state, a
- 3 nation or a political subdivision thereof or any agency
- 4 performing a governmental function <u>or a State-related</u>
- 5 institution and its affiliates.
- 6 "Governmental body with which a public official or public
- 7 employee is or has been associated." The governmental body
- 8 within State government, a State-related institution and its
- 9 <u>affiliates</u> or a political subdivision by which the public
- 10 official or employee is or has been employed or to which the
- 11 public official or employee is or has been appointed or elected
- 12 and subdivisions and offices within that governmental body.

- "Public employee." Any individual employed by the
- 15 Commonwealth, a State-related institution and its affiliates or
- 16 a political subdivision who is responsible for taking or
- 17 recommending official action of a nonministerial nature with
- 18 regard to:
- 19 (1) contracting or procurement;
- 20 (2) administering or monitoring grants or subsidies;
- 21 (3) planning or zoning;
- 22 (4) inspecting, licensing, regulating or auditing any
- 23 person; or
- 24 (5) any other activity where the official action has an
- economic impact of greater than a de minimis nature on the
- 26 interests of any person.
- 27 The term shall not include individuals who are employed by this
- 28 Commonwealth or any political subdivision thereof in teaching as
- 29 distinguished from administrative duties.
- 30 "Public official." Any person elected by the public or

- 1 elected or appointed by a governmental body or an appointed
- 2 official in the executive, legislative or judicial branch of
- 3 this Commonwealth, a State-related institution and its
- 4 <u>affiliates</u> or any political subdivision thereof, provided that
- 5 it shall not include members of advisory boards that have no
- 6 authority to expend public funds other than reimbursement for
- 7 personal expense or to otherwise exercise the power of the State
- 8 or any political subdivision thereof.

- 10 "State-related institution and its affiliates." Any of the
- 11 following institutions: Temple University, the University of
- 12 Pittsburgh, The Pennsylvania State University, including the
- 13 Pennsylvania College of Technology, and Lincoln University,
- 14 serving as instrumentalities of the Commonwealth within the
- 15 Commonwealth system of higher education, its graduate schools,
- 16 law schools, medical schools and their continental and
- 17 <u>international branch campuses</u>, as applicable. The term also
- 18 <u>includes any associated hospital, medical center, institute,</u>
- 19 facility, subsidiary or subordinate unit of any such
- 20 institutions.
- 21 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
