AN ACT

Amending the act of May 21, 1937 (P.L.774, No.211), entitled "An 1 act to facilitate vehicular traffic between the eastern and 2 western sections of the Commonwealth by providing for the 3 construction, operation and maintenance of a turnpike from a 4 point at or near Middlesex in Cumberland County to a point at 5 or near Irwin in Westmoreland County; providing for the 6 creation of the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission, and 7 8 conferring powers and imposing duties on said commission; authorizing the issuance of turnpike revenue bonds of the 9 Commonwealth, payable solely from tolls, to pay the cost of 10 such turnpike; providing that no debt of the Commonwealth 11 shall be incurred in the exercise of any of the powers 12 granted by this act; providing for the collection of tolls 13 for the payment of such bonds and for the cost of 14 maintenance, operation and repair of the turnpike; making 15 such bonds exempt from taxation; constituting such bonds 16 legal investments in certain instances; prescribing 17 18 conditions upon which such turnpike shall become free; providing for condemnation; granting certain powers and 19 authority to municipal subdivisions and agencies of the 20 21 Commonwealth to cooperate with the commission; and 22 authorizing the issuance of turnpike revenue refunding bonds," further providing for emergency vehicles. 23 24 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 25 hereby enacts as follows:

26 Section 1. Section 5.3 of the act of May 21, 1937 (P.L.774, 27 No.211), referred to as the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission 1 Act, is amended to read:

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
